METHODOLOGY

Work programme will cover interdisciplinary approach to the aviation employment for security and safety of a society and crisis response. Aspects explored will be connected with aviation training, organization, technical and operational capabilities. Diverse civil and state owned aviation assets will be examined, e.g. from Police, military, border guard or search and rescue services.

In today's world there are many hazards to deal with and it is hard to imagine countering crisis situations without aviation assets. So, during the Intensive Programme, air activities of great importance will be analyzed regarding disaster response, fire fighting and protection, medical, mountain and air-sea rescue, environmental monitoring, mass events and other public safety related issues. Different kinds of air activities will be taken into consideration on the basis of the five countries' lessons learned. The Programme will allow to exchange and compare experience and best practices with partner countries.

Work programme will consist of lectures, seminars, case studies and discussions, grouped in 6-hour subject-related modules. Lectures will be provided by teachers from participating institutions and also by experts and specialists from different Polish aviation organizations.

Participants will visit Polish Medical Air Rescue Unit in Warsaw, Polish Border Guard Aviation Unit and Naval Air Base in Gdansk and Police Aviation Unit.

As a result, participants will broaden their horizons and familiarize themselves with new solutions and fresh ideas, which will improve their competitiveness and value on the job market.

Participants will also take part in cultural programme and have a chance to visit Cracow, Gdansk and the capital – Warsaw, one of the most beautiful cities of Poland.
